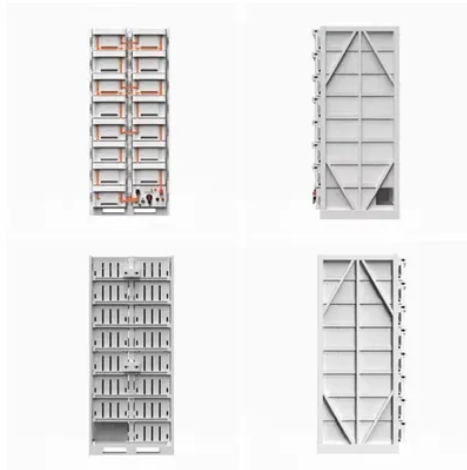




Battery should be replaced every few years
