Solar thermal-electric power systems collect and concentrate sunlight to produce the high temperatures needed to generate electricity. Solar thermal collectors are classified by the United States Energy Information Administration as low-, medium-, and high-temperature. Solar technologies convert sunlight into electrical energy either through photovoltaic (PV) panels or through mirrors that concentrate solar radiation. This energy can be used to generate electricity or be stored in batteries or thermal storage. This fluid then transfers its heat to water, which then becomes superheated steam. This steam is then used to turn turbines in a power plant, and this mechanical energy is converted into electricity. Harnessing solar energy for electric power generation is one of the growing technologies which provide a sustainable solution to the severe environmental issues such as climate change, global warming, and pollution.
