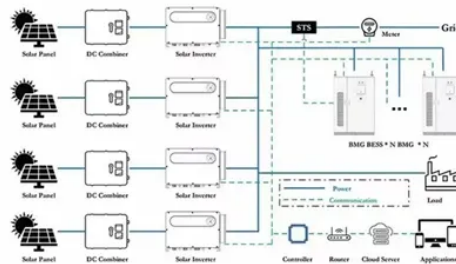

This control is called the transmission power control (Control Power).
